Dual Immersion Students

In 6th Grade, students will have 3 classes taught in Spanish:

DLI World Civilization – 1.0 Credit

DLI Culture and Media (Optional Elective) - .5 Credit

**The Dual Immersion classes takes the place of 1.0 Credits of Electives. Dual Immersion students will only have 1.0 total electives to choose.
